



GUIDELINES FOR DONATING A HORSE

All horses considered for adoption must–

- ♥ Be under 20 years old.
- ♥ Show no lameness at a walk, trot, or canter.
- ♥ Not have a major or chronic illness.
- ♥ Be gentle and bomb proof.
- ♥ Not have bad habits.
- ♥ Enjoy being in a herd.
- ♥ Like people.

Process –

- ♥ A pre-screening of the horse will be conducted by phone.
- ♥ A Horse Profile and Medical History must be completed by the owner at the time of a first visit by the Horse Specialist and/or the Riding Director.
- ♥ A horse may be accepted for a trial and/or training period of 30-60 days. During this time, the horse must pass ALL therapeutic horse's qualifications as deemed necessary by the Riding Director.
- ♥ After the trial period, a horse will either be accepted for adoption or not accepted and returned.



If accepted for adoption, an “Agreement for Donation of Horse” form will be completed and kept on file in the office. (Prior to recommending a horse – you can request a copy of this form). Questions regarding donating a horse should be sent to riding@horseswithheart.org.
